

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE MEMBERS OF  
THE WEST VIRGINIA BRITISH CAR CLUB, INC.  
JUNE 9, 2014**

**Old Business:**

- The minutes from the prior meeting which were previously distributed to members by email were offered for approval. R. Stephenson moves that the minutes be approved. The motion was seconded by K. Worthy. With all of those in attendance voting an approval, the motion was passed.

**Treasurer's Report:**

- Currently, there is approximately \$1,600.00 in the treasury.
- One new member bringing the total membership to 56.

**Events Report:**

- K. Worthy reports on the Club's drive to Hawks Nest. During the drive, the members stopped at the Mystery Hole as well as eating lunch at Smokey's at the Gorge. It was reported that the lunch was paid for by an unknown Club member.
- Club members discuss planning another event. K. Worthy suggests a possibility of a two-day trip to places such as Seneca Rocks or Snowshoe.
  - N. Arnett suggests traveling to the "Dragons Tail" in Tennessee.
  - S. Ewing suggests a one-day trip to Hinton, West Virginia.
  - B. Michael suggests an email to all members requesting a vote on whether a one-day or two-day trip would be preferable.
  - L. Kopelman suggests members travel to Talcott on July 12th for the John Henry Festival where the Esquires will be playing. In addition,

L. Kopelman reports that the Esquires will also be playing in Elkins, West Virginia on August 29<sup>th</sup> and in Summersville, West Virginia on September 13<sup>th</sup>.

- S. Ewing moves for the Club to plan a drive to Hinton on July 12<sup>th</sup> and return on Sunday the 13<sup>th</sup>.
  - B. Michael seconds the motion. Additional discussion was conducted by the members. D. Blackwood suggests that the Club rent a cabin for the members at Pipestem.
  - At the close of the discussion, the matter was voted on and approved by all members in attendance.
- R. Stephenson advised Club members that the Vintage Racing Group will sponsor the vintage races at Summit Point Motorsports Park on May 13-16, 2015, and the American MGC Register Association will be holding its national meeting in conjunction with it.
- S. Ewing suggests another picnic be held at R. Reese's following the July 5<sup>th</sup> regular meeting to be conducted at 10:00 a.m. B. Michael moves that the monthly meeting be held on July 5<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m. in R. Reese's garage with a picnic to follow. The motion was seconded by R. Reese and approved by a majority of all members in attendance.
- B. Michael suggests contacting S. Doty regarding scheduling a picnic at his place in August.
- K. Worthy indicates he is willing to plan an event for September. It is agreed that he will present his idea to the members at the July meeting for discussion.
- N. Arnett suggests the Club schedule a trip to a drive-in movie, or in the alternative using R. Reese's garage and projector.
- L. Kopelman reports that the East Bank Reunion will not be a fundraising event for the Club this year as it has been moved to the Moose Lodge. This move was necessary due to the fact that the Shrine was being rented out that weekend to another organization.
- L. Kopelman also reports that he owns a building which has rental space for 30 cars. L. Kopelman asks that those interested in renting spaces to contact him.

**Website Report:**

- B. Michael reports that he has moved the “Upcoming Events” to the front page of the Club’s website.
